The following is additional information for the 2010 HUD Notice of Intent.

CoC Name: TX503

Funding available for competition

Permanent Housing Bonus: \$401,884

This funding can only be used for homeless disabled individuals and families or chronically homeless individuals. As creating new permanent housing beds for disabled veterans is a HUD priority, HUD strongly encourages CoCs to use at least a portion of available bonus funds to create a project that will serve disabled veterans. Additionally, creating new permanent housing beds for chronically homeless individuals remains a HUD priority; therefore, HUD strongly encourages CoCs to use at least a portion of available bonus funds to create a project that will serve the chronically homeless.

PPRN: \$227,779

This funding can be expended on local projects that match HUD and local priorities.

NOTE: As a community we want to ensure that we maximize the resources available. Therefore, it is expected that applicants will either apply for the full amount available or will partner with an organization where the combined applications are for the full amount available.

Preliminary Local Priorities (Note these may change based on NOFA that is released).

Additional points will be awarded for local priorities, preliminary priorities below:

- **Priority:** Permanent supportive housing that has a strong emphasis on housing (in 09 had an 85% housing and 15% services ratio) for persons who qualify as chronically homeless and/or are veterans
- **Secondary priority:** Permanent supportive housing projects with a strong housing emphasis that move toward the goal of creating the 350 units in the City of Austin Council resolution
- **Acquisition, construction, renovation:** In order to increase permanent supportive housing stock, extra points will be given for projects that acquire, construct, or renovate housing. Applicants are encouraged to seek matching funds prior to application
- **Leveraging:** Both HUD and the local community will be focused on the amount of leveraging included in the application

- All CoC projects are required to participate in the Homeless Management Information System and NEW projects must include expenditures for HMIS as part of their line item budget. Note: all existing projects are encouraged to reallocate some of their expenditures toward HMIS.
