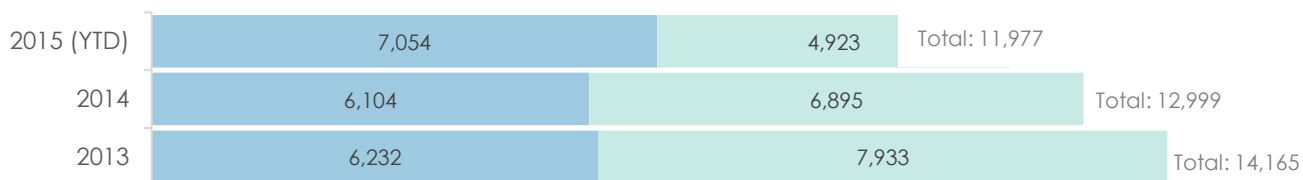

Austin/Travis County: January 1, 2015 - December 31, 2015

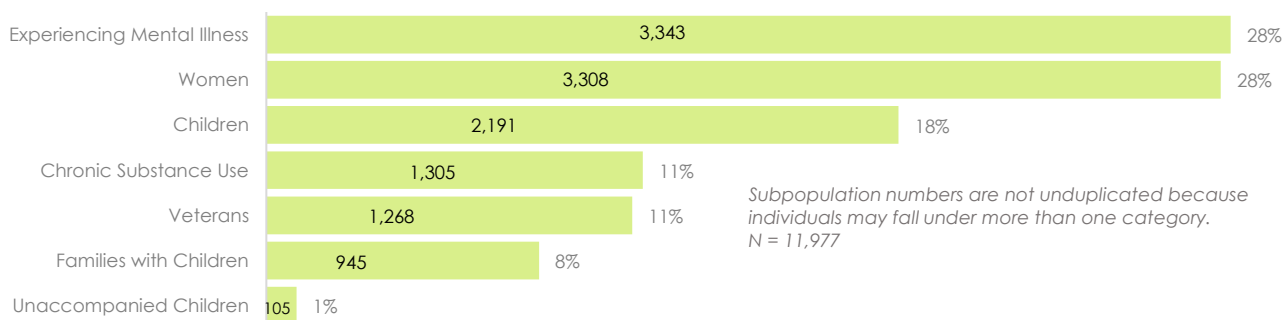
Total Individuals Served by the Ending Homelessness Continuum



Literally homeless: Individuals sleeping on the streets, in emergency shelters, or discharged from an institution where they resided for 90 days or less and were homeless upon institutional entry.

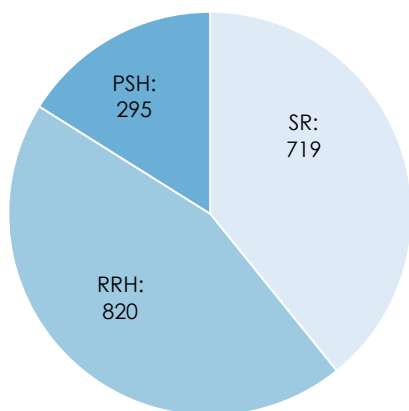
Not literally homeless: Individuals at-risk of homelessness or receiving housing stabilization services.

Total Housed in 2015 : 1,834 individuals

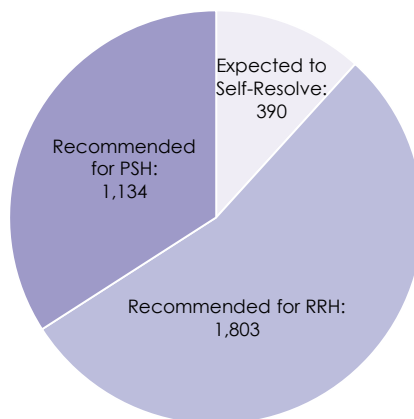


Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH): Housing intervention that includes on-going rental subsidy and support services.

Rapid Re-Housing (RRH): Short-term housing intervention that includes limited financial and support services.

Known Housing Need via Coordinated Assessment

Total Housing Need to Date: 3,421 households assessed



Self-Resolve (SR): Households that have the skills and resources to end their homelessness with minimal intervention from the homeless service continuum.
