## How can I apply for public housing/affordable housing/a housing voucher?

These waitlist applications are separate from the Coordinated Assessment process. To apply for these housing programs, you must apply directly to the individual program:

**Public Housing & Section 8**: Go to <a href="www.Austin.apply4housing.com">www.Austin.apply4housing.com</a> and submit your information. You must apply separately to every property you are interested in, and the Section 8 Waitlist is currently closed. If you previously submitted an application for any of these programs, go to <a href="www.hacanet.org/waitlists">www.hacanet.org/waitlists</a> to find out where you are on the waitlist.
