

2019 AUSTIN/TRAVIS COUNTY POINT IN TIME COUNT

Every year hundreds of volunteers head out early in the morning to count every person experiencing unsheltered homelessness in Austin/Travis Count. Volunteers count people in cars, tents, parks, under bridges, and on the streets. The information from this count is used to guide public policy and secure resources to help end homelessness in our community.

56% reduction in unsheltered homelessness among young adults (18-24)

Overall homelessness among unaccompanied young adults (18-24) down 25%

> 15% reduction in Veteran homelessness

Total homelessness in Austin/Travis County **up 5%** over last year
