We are pleased to share some updates about what ECHO staff has been working on this summer. On July 31 nearly 200 people attended the 2018 Solutions to Homelessness summer meeting to discuss the [Action Plan to End Homelessness](#) and encourage the community to get involved. Mayor Steve Adler and Senator Kirk Watson (D-TX) inspired the crowd with remarks about the progress in the community, and encouraged us all to step up and do more. A rousing drum roll announced new business and community partnerships and contributions from several participants, including Cielo Property Group and Amazon Web Services.

Judy Maggio facilitated a panel discussion including Mayor Pro Tem Kathie Tovo, Darilynn Cardona-Beiler from Integral Care and Susan McDowell from Lifeworks. The panel discussed community initiatives to end homelessness and how the City Council is addressing the issue of racial and economic division in Austin.
