- 1108 COVID-19 cases in Travis County. 25 deaths and 267 people recovered
 - At least 28 individuals experiencing homelessness have tested positive, including 2 that have recovered
 - The count of cases among people experiencing homelessness is likely an undercount due to private labs and providers not necessarily recording each person's housing status when they test
 - o Demographic information on cases available at http://www.austintexas.gov/covid19
- Integral Care behavioral health teams are providing remote services at Iso-Fac and Pro-Lodge sites
 - Starting today, Integral Care will have workers on site at these locations
 - Services include harm reduction measures
- New order from Austin/Travis County Health Authority stating everyone must wear a fabric mask when outside the home or in public
 - o Physical distancing of at least 6 feet between individuals in still in affect
- Austin City Council approved allocating \$15 million from their emergency reserve fund, RISE (Relief in a State of Emergency)

- Funding will go towards improving food access, case management, and assistance with rent/mortgage, utilities, and medical and childcare expenses

- Food access for people experiencing homelessness

 - Wes Bickham is the contact at to access the shelf-stable food bags being distributed out of the convention center
 - For information on availability and how to access food bags, call Wes at 512-492-5826
 - o In final stages of creating a web-based food distribution survey that will collect data on the number of food bags, meals, and water distributed to specific sites.
- Communications
 - o Press release put out that identifies 9 clusters of COVID-19 under active health investigation
 - A cluster is defined as 3 or more cases of COVID-19 in a single location
 - 1 cluster identified at The Salvation Army downtown shelter
 - Remaining 8 clusters are senior living or long-term care facilities
- DACC
 - o Continues to offer walk in case management triage services, 8am 5pm, Monday Friday
 - Served 432 individuals, approx. 17 people a day
- Motel Conversion Strategy
 - o City closed on purchasing Rodeway Inn
 - Will be starting renovations soon
