Sub-Goals:

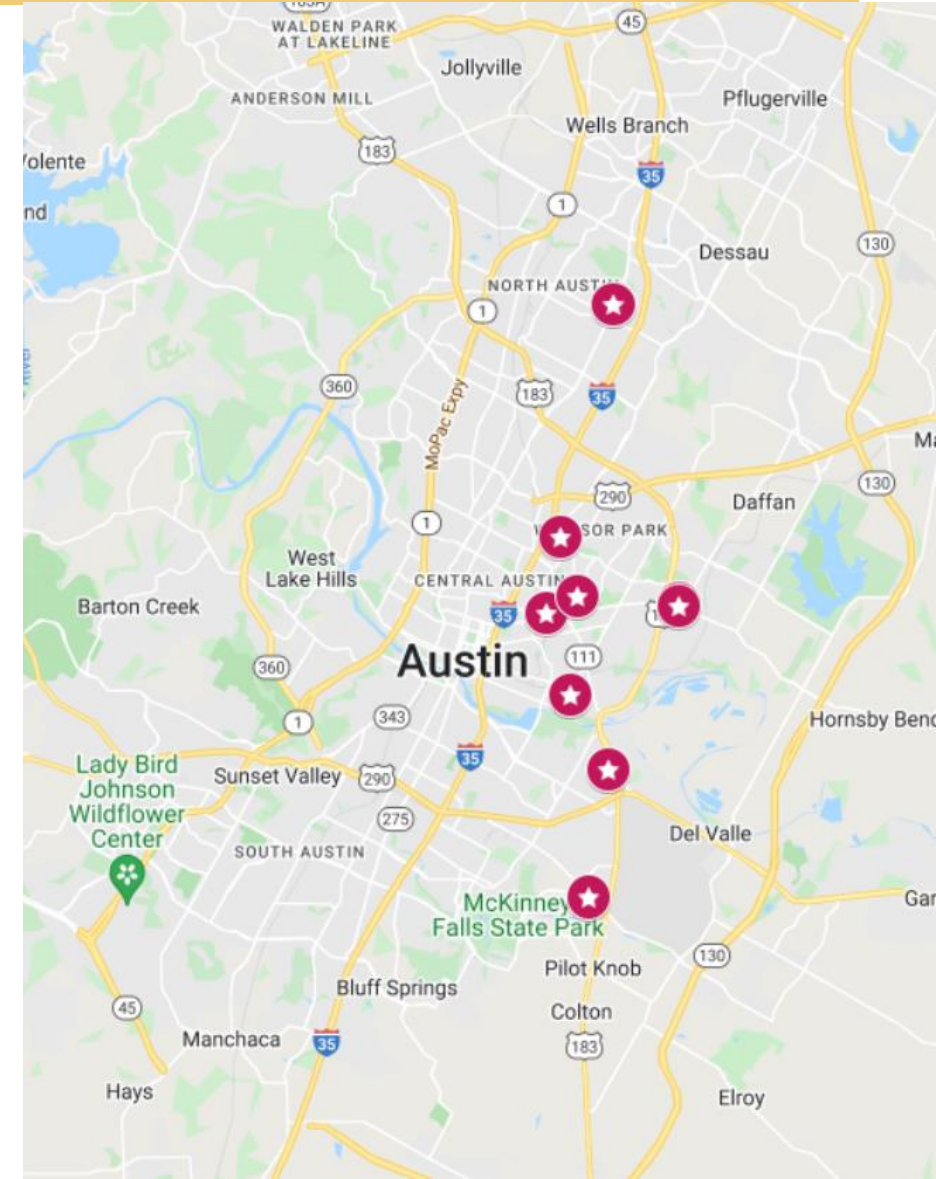
- ❑ Ensure a robust interagency, cross-sector approach to addressing homelessness

- ❑ Ensure equitable access to shelter, housing, and services
